The short-term homestay program offers teenagers opportunities to experience the **everyday life** of a host family in the USA.

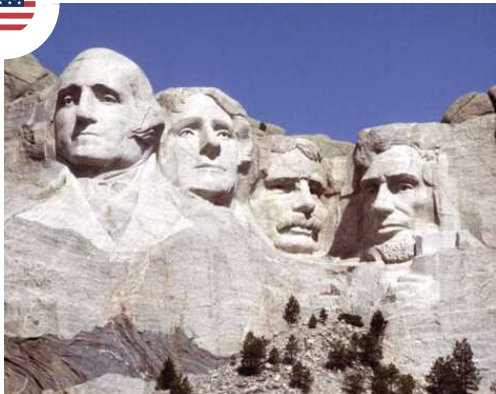
