

Boarding school in France: French Riviera boarding school

International students are placed in a selected private 5-day boarding school. Our partner school is located in the city center, and benefit from proper sports facilities; international students quickly feel «at home» in this school

French secondary education is divided into two tiers: the "collège" for the first four years (Grades 6-9); and the "lycée" for the last three years (Grades 10-12). Completion of secondary studies leads to the "baccalauréat". The school director makes the decision regarding grade and placement level for international students, taking into account the school organization, the students' transcripts and their French level. Students attend mandatory subjects:

- French.
- English and one extra Foreign Language,
- Mathematics,
- · History/Geography,
- o P.E.,
- Physics/Chemistry,
- · Biology,
- Economics ;
- o and 3 "spécialités" in grade 11 (2 in grade 12) among a 7 to 12 choices.

Graduation is possible after two study years (Grade 11 and 12).

A typical school day will follow the below schedule:

- 7am wake up
- 7.10am to 7.45am breakfast
- 8am the boarding house is closed
- 8.30am to 12pm morning classes
- 12pm to 1pm lunch time
- 1pm to 4pm afternoon classes
- 4pm to 5pm free time to relax
- 5pm or 6pm compulsory study time in a quiet environment
- 7pm to 7.30pm dinner time
- 8pm to 9pm compulsory study time in a quiet environment
- 9pm to 10pm free time to relax
- 10.15pm curfew

Supervised sport activities are offered on Wednesday afternoons or free time. La Seyne-sur-Mer (65 000 inhabitants) is located close to Toulon, on the seasidel

International students live at the school boarding house with their schoolmates during weekdays (Monday to Friday) and stay with a volunteer host family on weekends and during bank and school holidays.

There is a strong community spirit in these schools and students are involved in school projects as much as French students.

Application deadline: March 31st for an arrival in August, October 31st for an arrival in January. Late application may be accepted, depending on availability and visa processing

Requirements - Students must be interviewed in their home country before being accepted on the program. A minimum of two years of French study (A2 level) and good academic results are required.
