SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

The College welcomes over 7000 students from across the region and is located on Dorset's Jurassic Coast, which is England's first natural heritage site, and was the venue for sailing events at the 2012 Olympics. It is only two and a half hours from London city center by train!

The school offers excellent study facilities as well as a theatre, a restaurant, a Skills Center, a Media Centre as well as two sports centres. The College outdoor adventure activities include sailing, kayaking, canoeing and climbing. The College is so close to the beach that students can go there with their packed lunch or jump into the water after class! It is also at walking distance to the city center.

The College offers academic courses such as the A-Level but also a good range of vocational courses. College staff provides weekly tutorials to support international students with their studies, as well as English support classes and University guidance.

SCHOOL SYSTEM

AS and A-LEVEL Course (Year 12 and 13): Students may attend a combined Art course, Biology, Chemistry, English language, English literature, Film studies, Geography, Geology, German, Government & Politics, History, Law, Mathematics, Environmental Science, Media Studies, Photography, Physics, Psychology, and Sociology. The College has a 98% pass rate for international students for A-level exams

Vocational courses (Year 12 and 13): BTEC diplomas are offered in Applied Science, Architecture and Engineering, Art and Design, Business, Health and Social care, Information Technology, Public Services, Sports and exercise, Travel and Tourism.

Graduation is possible. Short term programs available (1 or 2 terms)
